Notice of 2023 Director Elections

Director Districts up for election in 2023:

District 1 (three-year term): Fox Township (Sullivan County), McNett Township (Lycoming County) and Canton Township (Bradford County)

District 5 (three-year term): Shrewsbury & Davidson Townships (Sullivan County), Penn, Franklin & Jordan Townships (Lycoming County)

District 7 (three-year term): Upper Fairfield Township (Lycoming County)

To be eligible for director candidacy and to serve on the Board you must be a legitimate, permanent resident of the district you seek to represent. Additional qualifications may be found on our website at www.screc.com by clicking on 'About Us' and 'Bylaws'.

Residential members from Districts 1, 5 or 7 interested in running for a position on the Cooperative's Board of Directors must be nominated by a petition signed by at least 10 members residing in the candidate's respective district.

Petition nomination forms can be requested starting on **November 17, 2022**. Completed petitions must be returned to the Cooperative office by **January 16, 2023 by 3:00 p.m.**

Qualified candidates who are approved by the Credentials & Election Committee will be asked to submit a picture and brief biography which will be included with the official ballot and published in *Penn Lines* and on our web page.

Ballots will be mailed to the entire membership during March 2023 and ballots must be received by 10:30 am on May 16, 2023. All members can vote for all directors and are encouraged to do so.

Directors serve three-year terms and are responsible for developing Cooperative policies, approving budgets, financial plans and setting rates. While they are elected from a district, they represent all members of the Cooperative.
