## **Director Districts up for election in 2022:**

District 2 (three year term): Hillsgrove and Elkland Townships (Sullivan County)

District 6 (three year term): Shrewsbury, Wolf and Mill Creek Townships (Lycoming County)

District 9 (three year term): Cascade, Lewis and Gamble Townships (Lycoming County)

To be eligible for director candidacy and to serve on the Board you must have been a member and bona-fide resident of the district by January 17, 2021.

Residential members from Districts 2, 6 or 9 interested in running for a position on the Cooperative's Board of Directors must be nominated by a petition signed by at least 10 members residing in the candidate's respective district.

Qualified candidates who are approved by the Credentials & Election Committee will be asked to submit a picture and brief biography which will be included with the official ballot and published in *Penn Lines* and on our web page.

Ballots will be mailed to the entire membership during March 2022 and ballots must be received by 10:30 am on May 17, 2022. All members can vote for all directors and are encouraged to do so.

Directors serve three-year terms and are responsible for developing Cooperative policies, approving budgets, financial plans and setting rates. While they are elected from a district, they represent all members of the Cooperative.
