General Items:

REAL ID or Passport Phone & Chargers

Toiletries and Personal Items

Refillable Water Bottle Medications (in original packaging)

COMFY Walking Shoes Khaki Bottoms for Capitol Hill Light Jacket or Sweatshirt Night/Chill Clothes

Umbrella/ Rain Jacket

General Clothing Rules:

Dress Code: All clothing must be appropriate and in good taste. Prohibited items include crop tops, short-shorts, short skirts, or excessively tight fitting clothing.

Good rule of thumb – if you would not wear it in front of your grandparents or to church, you should not wear it on Youth Tour...

Shirts and Shoes: Participants are required to wear shirts and shoes at all times.

Pretend Youth Tour is your local gas station and you are not allowed to enter without shirt and shoes...

Prohibited Apparel: Clothing displaying profanity, promoting political or gang affiliation, or featuring products or slogans related to tobacco, alcohol, or drugs.

If you are seen wearing any prohibited apparel, you will be asked to change immediately. If you continue to wear prohibited apparel, you will be sent home.
